Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 10:07. Cheryl made the motion to approve the May 2011 minutes. Motion was seconded and they were approved.

Treasurer's Report:

Bob reported that we made \$164.74 on the yard sale but total balance was to be determined.

Old Business:

Yard sale went well but snack/drink sales were low. Boy scouts were very helpful. For next yard sale we agreed to make sure attendees knew that they could not sell snacks/drinks. We need to advertise earlier and maintain a consistent yearly timeframe so HBTS members can count on there being a yard sale to get better attendance.

Current Business:

No one has yet signed up for the spring fling. There was a unanimous vote to cancel the spring fling. For future events, we discussed having the cut off date set earlier and also having a cheaper price for early sign-up.

New Business:

We tentatively set up two events: the next yard sale is in October on Saturday the 8th from 8 to noon and the "Santa's breakfast" is December the 17th. Bob to confirm the Beach House. A pancake maker was donated and we voted to donate a similar amount to the donor.

The inability to get interest for bigger events had the committee members present and discuss any ideas that may draw some HBTS interest. Some ideas were:

- 1) Bellangrath Gardens for the Winter lights show or earlier
Betty to call about group discounts, times, amenities and Bob to call the bus lines for fare info.
- 2) Blueberry picking
Everyone to check friends for interest and Betty to check place and best times.
- 3) Pontoon rental
Lee mentioned that he has already solicited interest from 11 couples. Lee to check costs for a Sept 10 timeframe. Everyone to check friends, clubs etc for interest.
- 4) Day trip to "Purple Parrot Resort" or similar
Tony called the Purple Parrot and they do not have "day trips". You can buy lunch but have no access to amenities.
- 5) Trip to a Casino
Good Time Tours already has a bus so its just a question of getting a group and going. Bob to check on times of bus pick up and return.
- 6) Flick and Float
Already have a Screen and projector
- 7) Dolphin Cruise from Destin
A 2 hour excursion for about \$20 per person includes beer and soda,
